### Complying with State Privacy Notification Laws

- Require companies to notify state residents whenever their unencrypted personal information is reasonably believed to have been obtained by an unauthorized person.
- Most state statutes require notification only if a breach compromises unencrypted personal information.
- Organizations that encrypt personal information not only better protect their customers but also avoid onerous notification obligations.
- Representative penalties: up to \$500,000 in fines per event.
